# Milldale Scout Camp Terms & Conditions



1. Arrival and Departure times are negotiable please ask at time of booking so arrangements can be made with the duty warden.
2. Deposit Payments to be made by bank transfer or cheque.

3. Charges are subject to change and are not necessarily those that were current at the time of making a booking. It is the responsibility of the Group to check up to date prices.
4. All camp fees must be settled before leaving the site unless specific arrangements have been made with the Booking Secretary.
5. We reserve the right to charge groups who damage the site or who fail to leave the site in a reasonable condition. Site must be left in a clean and tidy state.
6. Please take all rubbish away with you as we do not have a collection from the council.
7. The Camp/Activity Leader is responsible for the first aid for your group; we do not supply any First Aid Kits on site.
8. By booking Milldale, the Camp/Activity Leader is adhering to The Scout Associations Policy relating to Child Protection, to safe guard the welfare of all members by protecting them from physical or emotional harm.
9. Whilst we will always endeavour to allocate groups to the area within the camp site they have requested, if conditions so dictate, we reserve the right to move areas without prior notification.
10. Responsibility for the supervision and welfare of groups remains with the Camp/Activity Leader notified on the booking form.
11. Milldale reserves the right to send away from the site any person who, in the warden's judgement, is found to be unmanageable or a danger to the safety or enjoyment of others. In this event no refund will be given. Any additional cost and responsibility involved in removing that person will not be borne by Milldale or any of its representatives.
12. There is no telephone on site so please ensure you bring a mobile phone.
13. Any accidents, damage or breakages must be reported to the duty warden.
14. No pit fires or wet pits are to be dug. Alter fires are provided.
15. Chemical toilets must be emptied in the elsan disposal point.
16. Users of the site are not permitted to bring dogs onto the site, with the exception of guide dogs. Please inform all visitors.
17. The speed limit is 5 miles per hour on Milldale Scout Camp Site.
18. Vehicles are not permitted on the main camping field without the permission of the duty warden.
19. Both the Assault Course and Scramble Frame must only be used when supervised by a responsible adult. Weather and environmental conditions may affect the risks associated with these activities and must be taken into account by the supervising adult.
