<u>Injury from damaged equipment</u>							
Injury from damaged equipment / obstacles or debris	3	4	12	Prior to anyone using the assault course, the leader in charge should complete a walkthrough of the course, checking for damaged obstacles and any debris on the course that could cause injuries. Debris should be removed before the activity begins, and if any obstacles are damaged, they should not be used. (Damage should be reported to the campsite team.)	2	2	4
Slips Trips and Falls for all	4	2	8	If conditions are wet and participants are at risk of slipping, those obstacles should not be used.	2	2	4
Falling from the apparatus	3	4	12	Brief participants to climb to their ability, watch participants during the activity to ensure they remain within their apparent ability level	2	3	6
Fall due to pushing and shoving & boisterous activity	4	5	20	Activity to be monitored and any unruly behaviour to be controlled	2	5	10
<u>Swing Across Ditch</u>							
Rope Burn	3	2	6	During the activity advise to be given about risk of rope burns	2	2	4
<u>Climb & Descend</u>							
Fall from height	3	4	12	Minimum 1 leader to be situated at the bottom of this activity. Guidance given to each participant on how to descend from the activity	2	4	8
Rope Burn	3	2	6	During the activity advice to be given about risk of rope burns	2	2	4
<u>Army Steps and Jump</u>							
Legs getting trapped from missing a rung	3	2	6	Participants warned to take care in initial briefing and to watch footing on all obstacles	2	2	4
