Hit by a car in the car park / track	4	3	12	A group leader is to be at the car park to supervise arrival and departures. Max speed limit of 5mph and hazard lights used. Only vehicles with heavy equipment should be going down to the turning circle and vehicle movements restricted to arrival and departure where possible.	2	3	6
Fire	3	4	12	Leaders are responsible for fire precautions on their own sites and ensuring sufficient separation between tentage and adequate fire precautions are in place. Fire assembly point is by the barn.	2	4	8
Drowning in the stream	3	5	15	Leaders to brief participants of the hazard. No entry to the stream unless on an event activity.	2	5	10
Falling tree debris	2	4	8	Extra care to be taken in windy conditions. Concerns to be notified to Campsite Service Team	2	4	8
