Cart failure	3	3	9	Carts should be inspected prior to use to ensure wheels are secure and run freely, there are no loose nuts and the coconut matting on the underside of the cart is in place.	2	3	6
Crashes on the track / around the track	3	3	9	Participants to move off the track immediately – leader to control flow on track – 1 cart on each track at any one time. Bottom of track to be clear before top cart is loaded.	2	3	6
Trapping of hands / feet / bodies in the cart	3	4	12	Instruction from leaders keep all body parts inside the cart at all times by using handles on cart.	2	4	8
Excessive speed of cart due to reduced efficiency of braking system	3	4	12	Stop activity and inform campsite staff.	0	4	0
